- (To connect the BASIC cartridge to your cassette recorder, you will need a cable with one mini-phone plug on each end. This can be obtained at electronic parts & similar stores.)
- Insert the Astrocade (Bally) BASIC cartridge into the cartridge slot of your Pro Arcade and place the plastic overlay over the keypad.
 Press the RESET button.
 - 7. Place the Tiny Arcade tape into your cassette recorder. (Make sure the title of the program you wish to play is face up and that the tape is fully rewound.)
- 4. Insert one end of the cable into the jack on the BASIC cartridge. Plug the other end into the earphone or speaker jack of your recorder.
- 5. Adjust the volume control of your recorder about halfway. (If the recorder has a tone control, adjust it about halfway also)*
- 6. Enter: INPUT; RUN on the keypad.
 (Use the "Words" shift key to enter
 these commands-do not type them
 letter-by-letter.) Then press the
 GO key.
- 7. Push the play button of your recorder. The program will shortly begin loading into the computer's memory.
- 8. When the program starts, turn your recorder off.
- The programs on this tape are recorded twice per side. If the first recording fails to load properly, press RESET then enter: INPUT; RUN and GO again. The second recording follows the first by approx. 30 seconds.
- * (Because of the different circuitry of various cassette machines, it may be necessary to experiment with the volume and tone controls to get the most reliable loads.)
